

## BYO Drive access and printing


1. Follow through with the steps for enrolling into intune, this is essential to complete the remainder of the setup


2. In company portal scroll all the way to the right in the apps section and install the BYOx Mapper app

- Once Installed open the BYOx mapper app, you will be asked for your username and password. Enter them and click OK. This will map your home drive, your Data drive and Curriculum drive



- Click on the BYOx Mobility print link

- Click on the link corresponding to the device you are trying to set up printing on, follow the instructions and install the mobility print app.

6. Select the printers that you require to be installed. If you miss a printer you can always repeat the install to add it in later. Enter your username and password when prompted

## Set up printing on a Windows device

Click [this link](#) to download and run the **Mobility Print Printer** by PaperCut.

You'll be prompted to select the printers you want to use, and to enter your PaperCut username and password.

When it's time to print, just print like you normally do. Be sure to use a printer you selected when you installed Mobility Print.

**NOTE** Need to assign an account to your print job? You can do that at the printer or via the User Client.

### Device requirements

Mobility Print supports Microsoft Windows 7+.

7. Once installed you should be able to print to the school printers, print jobs will be charged to your school account as though you were using a school computer.
